CHP Membership in Local HPS Sections

I was curious what the distribution of CHPs in the local sections around the country were so I set out trying to gather this information, which was a lot easier said than done. The accompanying table lists the relevant data I was able to gather. In summary, complete data was available for 33 of the 48 chapters. The five chapters with the largest number of CHPs are Baltimore-Washington (86), East Tennessee (61), Columbia (57), New England (49), and Northern California (45). The five chapters with the largest percentage of their membership CHPs are Rio Grande (65%), Four Rivers (43%), Eastern Idaho (40%), Columbia (39%), and Deep South (38%).

Another interesting detail is to compare this data against the membership data collected by the Health Physics Society (HPS) and the American Academy of Health Physicists (AAHP). This data shows 683 CHPs as members of local chapters, with a total chapter membership of 3,584, while the AAHP has a total of 1,514 CHPs in its membership and the HPS has a total of 3,472 in its membership. It appears that CHPs are not necessarily members of their local chapters.
