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1994 ABHP Certification Exam

The 1994 exam year produced the largest number of applicants and candidates to date. This year, there was a total of 642 applicants (over a 50% increase from the number of 1992 exam applicants) which resulted in 417 candidates who took 323 Part I exams and 147 Part II exams.
