The AAHP Nominating Committee is seeking candidates to run for Academy offices on the 2022 ballot. Successful candidates will take office on January 1, 2023. We need nominees for the offices

of President-elect, Treasurer, and Director. All three positions are three-year terms.

Nominees must be:

- 1. Current plenary members of the Academy (either active or emeritus), and
- 2. Not serving an appointment to either of the Exam Panels, or as a member of the ABHP, at the time that they take office.

The Executive Committee meets in person once per year, during the HPS annual meeting. The President-elect serves one year followed by one year as President and a third year as Past-President. The President-elect is responsible for filling Academy Committees, and as President, presiding over the AAHP meetings. The past-President is responsible to organize and host the AAHP Special Session at the annual HPS meeting. The Treasurer serves two years as Treasurer and a third year as Past Treasurer and Chair of the Finance Committee. The Treasurer is responsible to oversee: 1) the collection and disbursement of the Academy's funds done by the Secretariat, and 2) the investment of Academy funds

according to the Academy's investment policy. The Directors attend the AAHP Executive Committee meetings and perform duties as requested by the President.

Please contact any member of the Nominating Committee to volunteer or nominate someone for service by October 15, 2021. Committee members are listed in the table below with the year that their term expires.
